



Documentation for a civil wedding in Ierokipia Municipality

THIRD COUNTRY CITIZENS

Regarding your civil marriage in Ierokipia Municipality you are requested to submit the following documents according to your nationality:

1. Certificate of Marital Status issued by a competent authority of the country of origin of the applicant with an official translation in Greek/English and duly certified. (valid for three months)
2. In case of divorce, a divorce certificate (final) with an official translation in Greek/English and duly certified.
3. In case of widowhood, death certificate of his spouse with an official translation into Greek/English and duly certified.
4. Birth certificate with an official translation into Greek/English.
5. In case of name change, we do need a deed of name change with an official translation into Greek/ English and duly certified.
6. Valid passport.

PLEASE NOTE that all public documents issued abroad must:

- a) bear an official translation into English from a sworn translator.
- b) Be certified with Apostille if the country has signed the Hague Convention of 1961 or Certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the country of origin of the applicant and then by the Embassy/Consulate of Cyprus in his country and then certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Cyprus.
- c) In the instance that the country of origin of the applicant has not signed the Hague Convention of 1961 and there is no Embassy /Consulate in the above mentioned country, the documents must be certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the country of origin of the applicant, then by the Embassy/Consulate of the issuing country in a third country, then by the Cypriot Embassy/Consulate in that third country and final by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Cyprus.

In case of permanent residency, please ask for advice as the procedure is different.
